Resolution No. (2) of 2005

Regarding Membership of the ITU Sector for Companies & Establishments

The Supreme Committee for the Supervision of the Telecommunications Sector,

having cognizance the Federal Law by Decree No. (3) of 2003, regarding the Organization of the Telecommunications Sector and its amendments, and

The Decision of the Supreme Committee for the Supervision of the Telecommunications Sector No. (3) of 2004 and its amendments on issuing the Executive Order of Federal Law by Decree No. (3) of 2003, regarding the Organization of the Telecommunications Sector, and

based on the presentation of the General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunication Sector and the approval of the Supreme Committee for the Supervision of the Telecommunications Sector.

it has been decided to:

Article One

The Supreme Committee empowers the Board of the General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunication Sector to correspond with the ITU regarding the membership in Union Sectors regarding any company or establishments that request membership (Radio, Standardization & Development) and as identified in the ITU Constitution (Recognize Operating Agency) as a company or agency or establishment.

Article Two

The General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunication Sector shall be entitled to obtain any needed undertakings from the said establishments or companies not to submit any document that may violate any policies, resolutions, instructions, rules and orders of the Supreme Committee, and of the General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunication Sector whenever the said establishments or companies participate in the ITU Meetings.

Article Three

The Authority shall withdraw the membership of any establishment or company from the ITU in case it violates the policies, resolutions, instructions, rules and orders of the Supreme Committee and the General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunication Sector.
