Resolution No. (5) of 2006

For Determining the Spectrum Use Fees

The Supreme Committee for the Supervision of the Telecommunications Sector,

having cognizance the Federal Law by Decree No. (3) of 2003, regarding the Organization of the Telecommunications Sector and its amendments, and

The Decision of the Supreme Committee for the Supervision of the Telecommunications Sector No. (3) of 2004 and its amendments on issuing the Executive Order of Federal Law by Decree No. (3) of 2003, regarding the Organization of the Telecommunications Sector, and

based on the presentation of the General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunication Sector and the approval of the Supreme Committee for the Supervision of the Telecommunications Sector,

it has been decided to:

Article One

Determine the fees for using the spectrum in regard to the permits, approvals and services provided by the Authority as specified in the attachment (Policy for Spectrum Fees) and shall apply on all parties in the State whether public or private and with no exceptions in order to guarantee the best use of these frequencies as the spectrum is a rare national resource owned by the State and licensed for use by the General Authority for Regulating the Telecommunications Sector. The Authority shall collect these fees and they shall be a financial revenue for the General Authority for the Regulating the Telecommunications Sector.

Article Two

This resolution shall be effective from the date of its issuance and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
